PRELIMINARY
MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
BETWEEN
UNIVERSITAS MUHAMMADIYAH SEMARANG
AND
EUR-ASIAN ON OCCUPATIONAL HEALTH
(EAFOH)

Article 1

The following Preliminary MoU will be the basis for the co-operation between the two institutions. Specific details of any activity between the parties shall be set forth in a bilateral supplementary Letter of Agreement.

Article 2

The objectives of this Preliminary MoU shall include, but not limited to the following:

1. The organization of joint academic and scientific activities;
2. Twinning Program/ Dual Degree;
3. Credit Transfer Program ;
4. Exchange lecturers and students in organizing academic activities;
5. Utilization of shared resources in the implementation of academic activities;
6. Scientific publishing;
7. Joint research, seminars, and other scientific activities

Article 3

The cooperating partners shall apply to the national governments or other suitable institution for funding to support their collaborative activities.

Article 4

Both institutes nominate a representative for co-ordination of co-operation.

The contact person for Universitas Muhammadiyah Semarang (Unimus) shall be the Head of International Office Affairs of Unimus, Muhammad Yusuf, Ph. D. The contact person for the European Forum on Occupational Health (EFOH) shall be the Chairman, Dr. Piet Kroon.

Article 5

This preliminary MoU shall become effective on the date that it is signed by the two parties. It shall be valid for a period of three (3) years, but may be renewed or extended by mutual consent. This preliminary MoU may be terminated by either party with six months prior notices.
